From the Pastor's Pen

"He is Risen!" "He is Risen Indeed!"

What a wonderful way to greet one another all month long – actually we should do it all year long! Christ has risen! That's what our faith in Christ is all about. But do you ever stop and wonder – Is there evidence to help us know for certain that Christ was indeed risen? Yes, there most definitely is evidence. Let me share briefly just a few things.

First, we believe the Bible is God's Word and we believe it is true. We would not have any of the New Testament beyond the four gospels if the resurrection of Jesus were not true.

Second, Christianity has continued throughout the centuries. Once again, if Christ had not been risen, Christianity would have died out before it even began.

Third, the disciples placed their entire message on the resurrection. Because they had seen and touched and eaten with the risen Lord, the disciples were changed men. They went on to boldly proclaim that Jesus was risen from the dead, even though that message cost them their lives. They would not stick so stubbornly to proclaim something that was not true. But it was true! Jesus was alive and they knew it.

Fourth, the body of Jesus was never found. Believe you me, the religious leaders desperately wanted to find the body of Jesus. But they could not – because it was not there. Instead right from the beginning a lie was spread about that the disciples had stolen the body. Read Matthew 27:57-66 and 28:11-13. Men have always tried to claim that Jesus was not risen, but no one has ever been able to prove it, because the truth is – He is Risen. He is Risen indeed!

Now, I want to pose a personal question to you: How have you allowed the Risen Lord to make a difference in your life? Ponder that question and do some soul searching during this Resurrection season and all year.


