From the Pastor's Pen

A Three Week Listening Tour

Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father. **Colossians 3:16-17** (NLT).

Stop and think about this: We are all a part of the Church of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Yet in all the conversations that take place before and after the worship service we seldom hear people talking about Jesus. Jesus is the King of kings, the Lord of lords, Jesus is the first and the last, the center and circumference. Jesus is superlative, superior, spectacular. His love is beyond our understanding. Everything is faded gray compared to Jesus, the bright and morning star.

My challenge is for each of us – myself included -- to go on a three week listening tour. As we talk and listen to others talking, let's see how often we can bring up the name of Jesus in the conversation?

Let's make an effort to come up to someone and say, "Wow, as I was studying my Bible this week I found this truth about Jesus that I had never understood before. I would like to share it with you."

We easily talk about the weather, how much rain is in the gauge, who won the latest game, all about graduation and a host of other things. But we seldom follow Paul's challenge in Colossians to let the message of Christ in all its richness fill our lives. There is nothing wrong with talking about the weather, but we could also talk about Jesus the weather maker. We might be surprised at the glory we might see as we let our message be about Jesus Christ, our redeemer.

As you listen, make an effort to bring the Lord Jesus into your conversations both at Church and when talking with people in general. More want to know more about Jesus than what we think. Our world has plenty of problems. The solution is Jesus Christ.

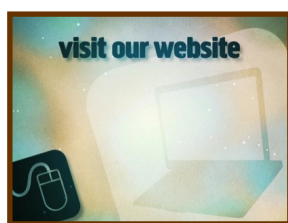
