THE LAMB OF GOD

Christians everywhere recognize the lamb as a familiar biblical image, connected with both Christmas and Easter. Though lambs aren't specifically mentioned in the Christmas story, they are implied because angels appeared to shepherds who were out in the fields tending their flocks. And the fact that Jesus was born in a stable assures us that animals were present, which would most certainly include lambs.

The Bible makes the connection between Jesus and lambs in several passages. Isaiah speaks of the Messiah as a lamb going to be slaughtered. (Isaiah 53:7) John the Baptist called Jesus the "Lamb of God" (John 1:29). Paul called Christ the "Passover Lamb." (I Corinthians 5:7). Peter spoke of Christ's blood as the blood of a lamb. (I Peter 1:18-19) The book of Revelation explicitly calls Christ "the Lamb" 30 times.

Think of some words we use concerning lambs: gentle, helpless, friendly and innocent come to mind. Compare that with the image of the snake used as a symbol for the devil. Children instinctively love lambs while most people fear snakes. The two animals are about as far apart on the emotional scale as you can get.

Community Christmas Dinner


