

From the Pastor's Pen

Greetings Church family.

Praise God! We are back meeting together. It has not been easy. It was quite easy (although I certainly did not like it) to close up the church building, lock the doors and not have a corporate worship service. But coming back together for a worship service has been a real challenge. There are so many regulations which we attempt to abide by. And people have such a wide variety of ideas as to what to do and what not to do. Getting all the technological stuff ready is still proving to be a challenge. As all of you decide what you will do, I would like to ask you to be in prayer for your pastor, for the elders, for the tech stuff and for every member of the body of Christ. Please come back knowing and accepting that things will be different – but in Christ we can handle that. Let the following verse be your guideline.

"For God has not given us a Spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind." 2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJ) This will be our verse for the remainder of May and the month of June.

Let's zero in on several words in this verse:

1. FEAR: This verse assures us that any fear we feel is not from God! At least 365 verses challenge us to "Fear not, because God is with us." In Christ we can replace fear with FAITH! God gives us the wisdom to be alert and aware, but not to fear. Our God is greater than anything we may face on this earth.

- 2 POWER: We don't have power on our own, but God has given us power through his Spirit. We need power to trust that God is with us through this all, that He is going to sustain us and in the end He will work it out for good. We need power to resist the lies and the spirit of panic with which the devil would love to paralyze us.
- 3. LOVE: Again, we don't have the ability to truly love as we should, but God has given us His perfect love. What a blessing. Let's open our hearts and make our love for Jesus and for our brothers and sisters in Christ even more real. Determine to love anyone who sees things different than you do. Let your love overflow to everyone.
- 4. SOUND MIND: the word used here in the Greek has the thought of a sober mind, a right mind, a mind that is able to think things through and is not 'drunk' with fear. How thankful we are that our awesome God has given us the ability to have a sound mind in all areas of life.

I am so looking forward to the day when we can openly fellowship and greet and hug. Until then we thank God daily for his grace and mercies.
