Fight Back

If we are going to be 'trouble makers' for Jesus we are going to be opposed big time. Here is what we do when we are under attack.

"Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." James 4:7

Here we see both a promise and a command.. If we submit to God, we may be sure that when we resist the devil, he will flee from us. In ourselves we have no power against the devil, but he has no power against us when we fight with God's power. By ourselves, we can't win; but with God's help, we can't lose.

The word "resist" is a military term. It means you stand and fight. You don't run away. We are to *flee* temptation, but we are to *fight* the devil. That means taking up the armor of God and standing in the evil day (Ephesians 6:10-17).

RightNow Media

Our Evangelism team is excited to bring **RightNow Media into our church to provide** meaningful scripture lessons to encourage growth beyond the Sunday worship service. We will be looking at Francis Chan's "Jesus's Farewell Message". This will be a 6 week study with each lesson video lasting approximately 15 minutes. This study will be offered at three different times. The first study will begin Sunday morning, February 26th at 8:00 a.m. in the Hebrew room. This study group will conclude on April 6th, Palm Sunday. The other two study sessions will be beginning Wednesday March 1st in the Hebrew room.
