#### GIVE ME LIBERTY OR GIVE ME DEATH

Christian men were instrumental in our nation's founding. Patrick Henry was one such man, He was a famous statesman and orator from Virginia. Virginia was deeply divided between those who were loyal to the King of England and those who wanted freedom from England. He represented Virginia at the Continental Congress where he uttered his most famous words: "Give me liberty or give me death." During the Revolutionary War Patrick Henry became commander-in-chief of Virginia's military forces. He helped draw up the Virginia constitution, as well as several amendments to the U.S. Constitution which became known as the "Bill of Rights". He became Virginia's first governor and was re-elected by a grateful people 4 times! Now pay attention to what this early and influential patriot said: "It cannot be emphasized too strongly or too often that this great nation was founded not by religionists, but by Christians – not on religions, but on the Gospel of Jesus Christ."
