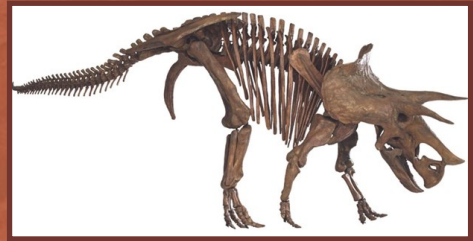


Pancake Supper
