A question for us today is: Do we KNOW Jesus enough to trust Him and to share about him?

A recent survey finds many unchurched would come to church if invited. Ninety-six percent of the unchurched are at least somewhat likely to attend church if they are invited. I repeat: . More than nine out of 10 unchurched people said they would come to church if they were invited. About 160 million people in the United States are unchurched or attend church two or less times a year. Another research showed that only 2 percent of church members invited another person to church in the last year. Perhaps even more surprising was the mostly positive attitude the unchurched had toward the church. The vast majority of the unchurched still perceive the church to be relevant in society today.

Jesus did not appoint angels to share his message. He has given us that task! We have three months left in 2023. It's a great time to invite people to church – for Thanksgiving, Christmas and definitely for our Creation Museum and Seminars on January 14,15,16, 2024. People need the Lord! Let's share the wonder of how He loves us!

# **New Church Directory**


